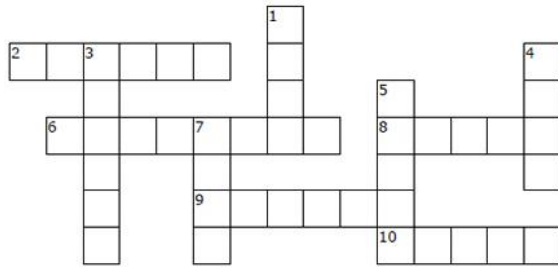


Crossword Puzzle
